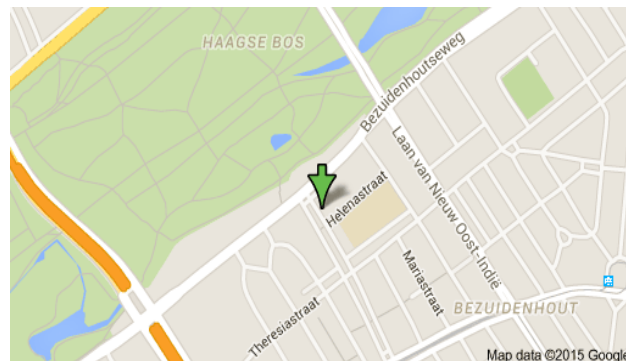

BRIEF PARISH HISTORY

Around 60 years ago, the community started with Fr. Willem Vroom, assisted by Fr. Theodore Zwartkruis (who later became the Bishop of the Haarlem Diocese). It began at the Laan Copes van Cattenburch, but as it grew, it moved premises, staying the longest, 25 years, at the St. Aloysius College in Benoordenhout. During this time of growth, the longest serving pastor was Fr. van Schaick, who led the parish for 22 years until his retirement in 1979. He was succeeded by seven other pastors on shorter term appointments.

In July of 1998, Fr. Sjaak de Boer was appointed Pastor of our parish. He is a Mill Hill Missionary and received his Ph.D. from Leuven University in Belgium. Before joining us, he worked in Kenya and Brazil as a University Chaplain and Pastor of the Itaguai Cathedral in Greater Rio de Janeiro. He has been the coordinator for English speaking parishes in European capitals since 2000, and a member of the Supervisory Board of CORDAID since 2014.

In December 2003, the parish moved into the church on Bezuidenhoutseweg 157. The building was purchased by our parish in July 2008. The official opening of the Pastoral Centre took place on 29 October 2011.

The Roman Catholic Church of Our Saviour has parishioners from approximately 70 different countries who come to worship and work together as one body. It is this solidarity that helps create the lively spirit which exists in our church.

We are a part of the Diocese of Rotterdam as a Non-Territorial Personal Parish.
