Lord of Miracles



The story of the Lord of Miracles began in the neighborhood of Pachacamilla, a place in Lima, Peru.



In 1651 a migrant drew the image of Christ on his wall.



In the years that passed, there were several earthquakes, but the image of Christ was never destroyed.



The survival of the image caused the number of devotees to increase, but the religious authorities of the time did not see it well.



A painter was sent to erase the image, but he was unable to remove it.



So a shrine was built around the image



Over time, the image became known as the “Lord of Miracles”



Later a chapel was built around the shrine.



A replica of the image was made and processed through Pachacamilla.



Today this massive procession occurs every year in Peru, but also other countries throughout the world.
